Erika's other works include a secular book The Wind Cries Mary: Murders That Shook a Power Town, that took place in her home town New Canaan, Connecticut. The book revolves around a murder that impacted the community when she was a child and enlisted criminal profiler Greg Cooper, a protégé of former FBI special agent, John E. Douglas, [11] who was his professional mentor for many years. [12]
